Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to exempt contracts relating wholly or partly to the conduct of games of Keno by a licensee under the *Public Lotteries Act 1996* in the casino from the provisions relating to controlled contracts in Division 2 of Part 3 of the *Casino Control Act 1992*.

This Regulation is made under the *Casino Control Act 1992*, including section 36.
