THREATENED SPECIES CONSERVATION ACT 1995 No 101

Notice of Final Determination and Amendment of Schedule 1 to Act

The Scientific Committee established under the *Threatened Species Conservation Act 1995* has, in pursuance of Division 3 of Part 2 of that Act, made a final determination to Insert the following species of plant in Part 1 of Schedule 1 to that Act (Endangered species) and, accordingly, that Schedule is amended as set out in Annexure "A" to this Notice:

Plants

ORCHIDACEAE

Diuris flavescens D.L. Jones

The final determination to insert this species in Part 1 of Schedule 1 has been made because the Scientific Committee is of the opinion that the species is likely to become extinct in nature in New South Wales unless the circumstances and factors threatening its survival cease to operate.

Schedule 1 to the *Threatened Species Conservation Act 1995* is amended by inserting, in Part 1 in alphabetical order under the heading "Plants" and the sub-heading "Orchindaceae" the matter:

Diuris flavescens D.L. Jones
