**ROAD TRANSPORT (DRIVER LICENSING) ACT 1998 No 99—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence provisions of the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Act 1998* that make changes relating to certain penalties and disqualifications, and create a new offence, under the *Traffic Act 1909*.
