Explanatory note

The *Trustee Companies Act 1964* contains references to the Corporate Affairs Commission. Section 96 of the *Corporations (New South Wales) Act 1990* provides for the making of regulations that relate to the construction of a reference to the Commission. The object of this Regulation is to provide for the construction of a reference to the Commission in section 31C (Orders where prohibited acquisitions take place) of the *Trustee Companies Act 1964* as a reference to the Director-General of the Attorney General's Department. In addition, the Regulation omits a similar construction in relation to a provision (section 29D (2) (a)) that has been amended by an Act.

This Regulation is made under the *Corporations (New South Wales) Act 1990*, including section 80.
