Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to require a statutory body to include in its 1997-1998 and subsequent annual reports information about its implementation of the Government's *Action Plan for Women* (published November 1996), including the Plan's key objectives, goals and strategies in respect of which the statutory body has taken action during the reporting year and the actual outcomes achieved during the year.

This Regulation is made under the *Annual Reports (Statutory Bodies) Act 1984*, including sections 9 and 17 (the general regulation making power).

In the case of a statutory body's annual report for its 1997–98 financial year, and any subsequent financial year, a statement setting out the following:

- (a) a brief description of the Government's philosophy in relation to women and the whole of Government approach to addressing women's issues and concerns,
- (b) Government policy orientations in relation to women's interests in the specific areas in which the statutory body operates,
- (c) the key objectives, as stated in the *Action Plan for Women*, under which the statutory body took action during the reporting year.
- (d) the specific goals and strategies, as stated in the *Action Plan for Women*, that the statutory body has committed to and the actual outcome for women achieved during the reporting year through the implementation of those strategies,
- (e) reference to sources of further information in relation to the statutory body's strategies regarding women
