EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the *Administrative Decisions Tribunal Legislation Amendment Act 1998* except for provisions that confer jurisdiction on the Administrative Decisions Tribunal to review certain decisions made under the following Acts and regulation:

- (a) the *Firearms Act 1996* and *Firearms (General) Regulation 1997* (Schedule 2.6 and 2.7),
- (b) the *Forestry Act 1916* (Schedule 2.8),
- (c) the *Timber Marketing Act 1977* (Schedule 2.21).
