**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the *Administrative Decisions Tribunal Legislation Further Amendment Act 1998* except for:

- (a) certain provisions amending the *Administrative Decisions Tribunal Act 1997* that relate to the establishment of an Occupational Regulation Division of the Administrative Decisions Tribunal and the allocation of functions to the division (Schedule 1 [21]-[24]), and
- (b) certain provisions that would confer jurisdiction on the Administrative Decisions Tribunal to review decisions made under the *Animal Research Act 1985* (Schedule 3)
