The object of this Rule is to amend Part 9, rule 27 of the *District Court Rules 1973* to ensure that the obligation to serve particulars and supporting reports under that rule in relation to claims for damages in respect of personal injuries does not extend to proceedings in which such a claim is accompanied by a notice of motion seeking a separate trial on the issue of liability or seeking to place the action in the not ready list.
