## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to amend Schedule 1 to the *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985* so as to add the substance 4-Methylthioamphetamine (commonly known as “Flatliner”) to the list of prohibited drugs contained in that Schedule.

This Regulation is made under the *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985*, including section 44 (the power to make regulations amending Schedule 1 to that Act).
