Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to require a casino operator to notify the Minister of the particulars of any employee who is paid \$150,000 or more per year (at present, the amount is set at \$100,000).

This Regulation is made under the *Casino Control Act 1992*, including the definition of "minor change" in section 35 (1).
