Explanatory note

Clause 47 of the *Roads (General) Regulation 1994* prohibits the carrying out of certain commercial and other activities on the Sydney Harbour Bridge except where those activities are carried out under a permit issued by the RTA.

The object of this Regulation is to amend clause 47 so that it also applies to the ANZAC Bridge.

This Regulation is made under the *Roads Act 1993*, including section 244 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Roads (General) Amendment (ANZAC Bridge) Regulation 1999*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 5 March 1999.
