Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to repeal provisions of the *Transport Administration (General) Regulation 1995* relating to the transport of dangerous goods by rail as a consequence of those provisions being superseded by the making of the *Road and Rail Transport (Dangerous Goods) (Rail) Regulation 1999*.

This Regulation is made under the *Transport Administration Act 1988*, including section 99 and section 119 (the general regulation-making power).
