Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to update an index number that is used for the purposes of the indexation of the amounts of benefits under the *Workers Compensation Act 1987*.

This Regulation is made under the *Workers Compensation Act 1987*, including section 79 (the definition of **latest index number**) and section 280 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Workers Compensation (General) Amendment (Index Number) Regulation 1999*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 31 March 1999.
