Explanatory note

The objects of this regulation are as follows:

- (a) to remove the requirement for an annual list to be published in the Government Gazette of unclaimed prizes of \$200 or more won on a public lottery,
- (b) to require a public lottery licensee to notify the Minister of the particulars of any employee who is paid \$150,000 or more per year (at present, the amount is set at \$100,000).

This Regulation is made under the *Public Lotteries Act 1996*, including section 83.
