EXPLANATORY NOTE

This proclamation commences amendments to the *Supreme Court Act 1970* that abolish all existing Divisions of the Court other than the Common Law Division and the Equity Division, provide for the assignment of proceedings to those remaining Divisions and enable the Chief Justice to designate Judges of the Court to be List Judges.
