**PRIVACY AND PERSONAL INFORMATION PROTECTION
ACT 1998 No 133—PROCLAMATION**

(L.S.) GORDON SAMUELS, Governor.

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 1 June 1999 as the day on which the following provisions of that Act commence:

- (a) Part 1,
- (b) sections 29–31,
- (c) Divisions 2 and 3 of Part 4,
- (d) sections 61, 64–70, 71 (2) and (3) and 75,
- (e) section 73 to the extent that it repeals the remaining provisions of the *Privacy Committee Act 1975*,
- (f) Schedule 3.1–3.7,
- (g) clauses 3–5 of Schedule 4.
