Explanatory note

This Regulation increases from \$295 to \$302 the maximum amount of the minimum ordinary rate that a council may, without special Ministerial approval, make under section 548 of the *Local Government Act 1993*.

This Regulation is made under the *Local Government Act 1993*, including sections 548 (3) (a) and 748 (the general regulation-making power).

3 Amendment of clause 6A of Local Government (Rates and Charges) Regulation 1993

Clause 6A of the *Local Government (Rates and Charges) Regulation 1993* is amended by omitting the matter “\$295” and by inserting instead the matter “\$302”.
