Companion Animals Act 1998 No 87—Proclamation

Explanatory note

The object of this proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the *Companion Animals Act 1998*.

Those provisions relate to the following matters:

- (a) the compulsory identification and registration of dogs and cats,
- (b) new cat control measures,
- (c) the repeal of the remaining unrepealed provisions of the *Dog Act 1966* and the *Dog Regulation 1997*.
