ACT 1998 No 133—PROCLAMATION**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence provisions of the Act:

- (a) relating to the requirement for public sector agencies to prepare and implement privacy management plans, and
- (b) that contain offences relating to the corrupt disclosure and use of personal information by public sector officials and to the supply of personal information that has been obtained unlawfully.
