Water Legislation Amendment Act 1997 No 128—Proclamation

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence certain uncommenced provisions of the *Water Legislation Amendment Act 1997*. Those provisions amend the *Water Act 1912* to include Sydney Water Corporation Limited as a water management authority under that Act and provide that it is taken to have applied for a water management licence under Part 9 of that Act.
