## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 1994* as a consequence of the transfer to the Department of Urban Affairs and Planning of certain building control functions that have previously been exercised within the Department of Local Government.

This Regulation is made under the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*, including section 157 (the general power to make regulations).

**1    Name of Regulation**

## Schedule 1 Amendments

(Clause 3)

**[1] Clause 80H Modification and supplementation of Building Code of Australia standards**

Omit “Director-General of the Department of Local Government”  
wherever occurring.

**[2] Clause 80K Offences relating to certain Crown property**

Omit “administering the *Local Government Act 1919*”.

**[3] Clauses 81H, 81I, 81J and 81M**

Omit “Director-General” wherever occurring.

Insert instead “Director”.

**[4] Clause 81FF Definition**

Omit the clause.

**[5] Clauses 81GG, 81HH, 81II, 81JJ, 81KK and 81LL**

Omit “Director-General” and “Director-General’s” wherever occurring.

Insert instead “Director” and “Director’s”, respectively.
