Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to remove the port of Coffs Harbour from the list of ports that are prescribed as “State waters” for the purposes of the *Marine Pollution Act 1987*. The Regulation also corrects a typographical error.

This Regulation is made under the *Marine Pollution Act 1987*, including paragraph (c) of the definition of “State waters” in section 3(1) and section 61 (the general regulation-making power).
