Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to confer investment powers under Part 4 of Schedule 4 to the *Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Act 1987* on the NSW Insurance Ministerial Corporation (currently the Corporation has investment powers under Part 1 of Schedule 4 to that Act).

This Regulation is made under the *Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Act 1987*, including section 43 (the general regulation-making power) and section 24.
