Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence all the provisions of the *Evidence (Children) Act 1997* except Part 2. Part 2 requires an investigating official who questions a child in connection with the investigation of the commission, or possible commission, of an offence to ensure that any representation made by the child that may be adduced as evidence in court is recorded.
