Home Building Amendment Act 1999 No 26—Proclamation


GORDON SAMUELS, Governor.

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Home Building Amendment Act 1999*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 30 July 1999 as the day on which that Act commences, except for the following provisions:

- (a) Schedule 1 [2]—[8],
- (b) Schedule 1 [21],
- (c) Schedule 1 [23].

Explanatory note

The object of this proclamation is to commence the provisions of the *Home Building Amendment Act 1999* except for those that establish a new regime that makes the ability to comply with insurance requirements a prerequisite to the granting, renewal or restoration of a licence, and provides for the Director-General to suspend a licence if the Director-General is of the opinion that the holder of the licence has not complied with the holder's insurance obligations.
