I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Mines Inspection Amendment Act 1998*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 30 July 1999 as the day on which that Act commences, with the exception of Schedule 1 [20] to that Act in so far as it inserts section 18B in the *Mines Inspection Act 1901*.
