Explanatory note

Under the *Superannuation Act 1916*, employers within the meaning of that Act are required to make superannuation contributions in respect of certain employees to a fund kept under the Act. Schedule 3 to the Act lists organisations and bodies that are employers for the purposes of the Act. Section 92 of the Act authorises the Governor-in-Council, by Order, to amend the Schedule.

The object of this Order is amend Schedule 3 to the Act to include Sydney Catchment Authority in the list of employers.
