Marine Safety Act 1998 No 121—Proclamation

Explanatory note

The *Marine Safety Act 1998* will, on its commencement, repeal a number of existing Acts and regulations under those Acts relating to marine safety (those existing Acts and regulations are set out in Schedule 2 to the *Marine Safety Act 1998*). The object of this proclamation is to commence the provision of the *Marine Safety Act 1998* that prevents those existing regulations from being repealed beforehand under the staged repeal provisions of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*.
