## Courts Legislation Amendment Act 1999 No 39—Proclamation


JAMES JACOB SPIGELMAN,

- (a) Schedules 1, 2, 3, 5, 7 and 8, and
- (b) Schedule 4 [4]–[32].

### Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence amendments to the *Criminal Appeal Act 1912*, the *Industrial Relations Act 1996*, the *Jury Act 1977*, the *Land and Environment Court Act 1979*, the *Supreme Court Act 1970* and the *Wills, Probate and Administration Act 1898*. The Proclamation also commences the remaining uncommenced amendments to the *Justices Act 1902* made by Schedule 4 to the Act.

Schedule 6 to the Act, which remains uncommenced, deals with amendments to the *Local Courts (Civil Claims) Act 1970*.
