Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the remaining uncommenced provisions of the *Home Building Amendment Act 1999*, which relate to the establishment of a new regime that makes the ability to comply with insurance requirements a prerequisite to the granting, renewal or restoration of a licence, and provides for the Director-General to suspend a licence if the Director-General is of the opinion that the holder of the licence has not complied with the holder's insurance obligations.
