### **Explanatory note**

The object of this Proclamation is to commence Schedule 1 [4], [5] and [6] to the *Roads Amendment (Transitways) Act 1999*. These provisions make amendments to the *Roads Act 1993* that are consequential on the replacement of the *Traffic Act 1909* by the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* and the other road transport legislation referred to in that Act.
