### Explanatory note

The object of this proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the *Irrigation Corporations Amendment Act 1998* that convert Coleambally Irrigation Corporation from a statutory State owned corporation to a company State owned corporation and will enable its further conversion to a class 2 irrigation corporation (owned by irrigators) at a later date by proclamation under the *Irrigation Corporations Act 1994*.
