## Liquor Amendment Act 1999 No 63—Proclamation

### Explanatory note

The object of this proclamation is to commence uncommenced provisions of the *Liquor Amendment Act 1999* other than Schedule 1[43], [44] and [56]. The items not being commenced relate to amendments to section 101 (Control of licensed premises) of the *Liquor Act 1982* and the insertion of sections 117EA to 117ED relating to "proof of age cards" into that Act.
