Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to confer investment powers under Part 3 of Schedule 4 to the *Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Act 1987* on Charles Sturt University. Currently Charles Sturt University has investment powers under Part 1 of Schedule 4 to that Act.

This Regulation is made under the *Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Act 1987*, including section 24 and section 43 (the general regulation-making power).
