**TOW TRUCK INDUSTRY ACT 1998 No 111—PROCLAMATION**

(L.S.) GORDON SAMUELS, Governor.

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Tow Truck Industry Act 1998*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 19 February 1999 as the day on which the following provisions of that Act commence:

- (a) Parts 1 and 2,
- (b) sections 91–93, 104, 105 (1) and 106,
- (c) section 107 (1), (but only to the extent that it repeals sections 56 and 60 of the *Tow Truck Act 1989*, Part 6 of that Act and Schedules 1 and 2 to that Act),
- (d) Schedule 1,
- (e) Schedule 2 (except clauses 5–8).
