**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this proclamation is to commence certain provisions of the *Administrative Decisions Legislation Amendment Act 1997* that would confer jurisdiction on the Administrative Decisions Tribunal to review decisions made under the following Acts:

- (a) the *Apiaries Act 1985* (Schedule 5.3),
- (b) the *Fertilizers Act 1985* (Schedule 5.12),
- (c) the *Firearms Act 1996* (Schedule 5.13),
- (d) the *Fisheries Management Act 1994* (Schedule 5.14),
- (e) the *Horticultural Stock and Nurseries Act 1969* (Schedule 5.17),
- (f) the *Non-indigenous Animals Act 1987* (Schedule 5.20),
- (g) the *Plant Diseases Act 1924* (Schedule 5.23),
- (h) the *Stock (Artificial Breeding) Act 1985* (Schedule 5.27).
