EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence all of the provisions of the *Police Service Amendment (Complaints and Management Reform) Act 1998*, except for Schedule 1 [1], [2] and [8] and Schedule 2.1. Those amendments, which deal with the abolition of the Police Tribunal, are intended to be commenced at a later date.
