**RETAIL LEASES AMENDMENT ACT 1998 No 169—  
PROCLAMATION**

(L.S.) GORDON SAMUELS, Governor.

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Retail Leases Amendment Act 1998*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 1 March 1999 as the day on which that Act commences, with the exception of the following provisions:

Schedule 1 [34]

Schedule 1 [49] to the extent that it inserts section 71A of the *Retail Leases Act 1994*

Schedule 1 [51], [52] and [55]

Schedule 1 [56] to the extent that it inserts section 77 (2)–(7) of the *Retail Leases Act 1994*

Schedule 2 item 2.1 [2] to the extent that it inserts clauses 3 (2) and 4 of Part 3B of Schedule 2 to the *Administrative Decisions Tribunal Act 1997*.
