Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to confer on the Environmental Trust investment powers under Part 1 of Schedule 4 to the *Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Act 1987*. The Regulation also omits redundant references to dissolved Trusts.

This Regulation is made under the *Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Act 1987*, including section 24 (investment powers of authorities) and section 43 (the general regulation-making power).
