Gambling Legislation Amendment (Responsible Gambling) Act 1999 No 49—Proclamation



- (a) Schedule 1 [6], and
- (b) Schedule 2 [3] and [10], and
- (c) Schedule 6 [8] and [10].

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence provisions of the *Gambling Legislation Amendment (Responsible Gambling) Act 1999* that allow courts to make remedial orders in respect of certain offences, and that allow registered clubs and hotels to establish schemes by which persons can exclude themselves from parts of a club or licensed premises used for gambling.
