# Children and Young Persons Legislation (Repeal and Amendment) Act 1998 No 158—Proclamation

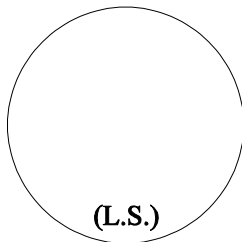

- (b) Schedule 1 [5].

## Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence an amendment to the *Children's Court Act 1987* providing that on the appointment of a Senior Children's Magistrate, the Magistrate is taken to be a Deputy Chief Magistrate under the *Local Courts Act 1982*.
