
State Revenue Legislation Amendment Act 1999 No 10—Proclamation

Explanatory note

The object of this proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the *State Revenue Legislation Amendment Act 1999*. These provisions amend the *Land Tax Act 1956* and the *Premium Property Tax Act 1998* in relation to the rounding off of land tax assessments and the *Land Tax Management Act 1956* in relation to discounts for early payment of land tax.
