Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to increase, from \$25 to \$27.50, the minimum fee payable for each special service in relation to the Registry of Births, Deaths and Marriages for which no fee is otherwise provided in Schedule 1 to the *Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Regulation 1996*. The fee for each such special service is a fee approved by the Registrar of Births, Deaths and Marriages having regard to the work involved in providing the service.

This Regulation is made under the *Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Act 1995*, including sections 54 and 62 (the general regulation-making power).

The *Births, Deaths and Marriages Registration Regulation 1996* is amended by omitting from item 9 of Schedule 1 (Fees) the matter “25.00” and by inserting instead the matter “27.50”.
