





## Marine Safety Act 1998 No 121—Proclamation

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels AC, CVO, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 1 July 2000 as the day on which Schedule 3.5 to that Act, and section 142 of that Act in its application to Schedule 3.5, commence.
