## Olympic Arrangements Act 2000 No 1—Proclamation



- (a) Part 3, and
- (b) Schedule 1.

### Explanatory note

The object of this proclamation is to commence so much of the *Olympic Arrangements Act 2000* as sets out provisions that are to be construed as part of the *Banks and Bank Holidays Act 1912* and the *Factories, Shops and Industries Act 1962* for the purposes of the Olympic Games. Parts 1 and 11 of the *Olympic Arrangements Act 2000* commenced on the date of assent.
