Explanatory note

Currently, the *Conveyancers Licensing Regulation 1993* includes an exemption from the requirement for a licensed conveyancer to hold approved professional indemnity insurance under the *Conveyancers Licensing Act 1995* if the conveyancer holds one of certain specified policies. The object of this Regulation is to remove that exemption. Equivalent policies will be declared by order under that Act to be approved policies.

This Regulation is made under the *Conveyancers Licensing Act 1995*, including sections 12 (3) and 91 (the general regulation-making power).
