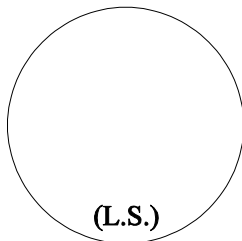
## Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (No 2) 1999 No 85—Proclamation

### Explanatory note

The object of this proclamation is to commence the uncommenced provisions of the *Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1999* that amend the *Electricity Supply Act 1995*. Those amendments relate to arrangements under which the price for the provision of electricity network services by a licensed electricity distributor will be determined by the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal under the *National Electricity Code* rather than under the *Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal Act 1992* as is currently the case.
