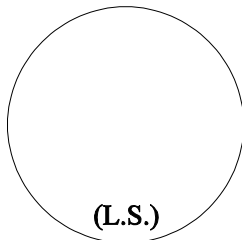
Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998 No 133— Proclamation

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the remaining provisions of the *Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act 1998* that have not yet been commenced. The provisions concerned include Part 2 of the Act (Information protection principles), section 32 (Agencies to comply with privacy codes of practice), Part 5 (Review of certain conduct) and Part 6 (Public registers).
