Explanatory note

The *Annual Reports (Departments) Act 1985* requires the annual reports of Departments to be presented to Parliament. Clause 11 (3) of the *Annual Reports (Departments) Regulation 1995* provides that an additional copy of an annual report of a Department is to be provided to the Clerk of the Parliaments and the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly in a computer readable form. The object of this Regulation is to remove the requirement for an additional computer readable copy to be provided to Parliament.

The Regulation is made under the *Annual Reports (Departments) Act 1985*, including section 20 (the general regulation-making power).
