Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to declare that the Prospect Reservoir and certain land surrounding that reservoir are controlled areas for the purposes of the *Sydney Water Catchment Management Act 1998*.

This Order is made under section 51 of that Act.

Sydney Water Catchment Management (Controlled Areas) Order 2000

1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Sydney Water Catchment Management (Controlled Areas) Order 2000*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on 1 July 2000.

3 Controlled areas

The Prospect Reservoir and the area of land surrounding that reservoir, as shown red on the map marked “Prospect Reservoir, Controlled Area”, dated 1 July 2000 and deposited in the office of the Sydney Catchment Authority, are declared to be controlled areas for the purposes of section 51 of the *Sydney Water Catchment Management Act 1998*.
